A screening colonoscopy can turn into a diagnostic colonoscopy, For example; if during the screening, a polyp is found and removed, or any other diagnostic issue, it becomes a diagnostic colonoscopy.

Insurances could pay differently for screening colonoscopies than diagnostic colonoscopies. If you have a diagnostic colonoscopy, you may have more out of pocket expense, including lab and pathology charges.
